I have decided to concentrate on his playing and managing days in Chicago.

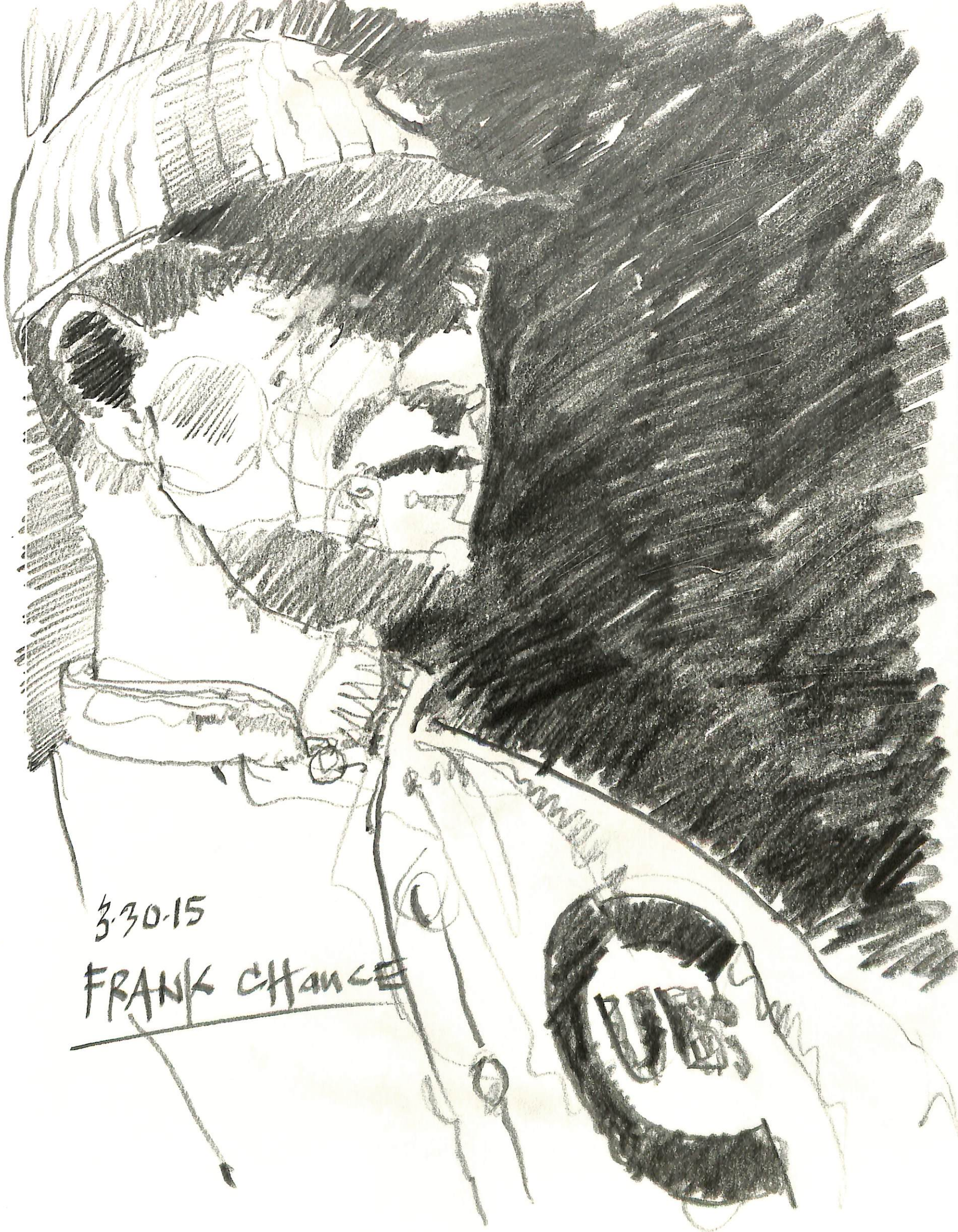
