had been inducted into the HOF.



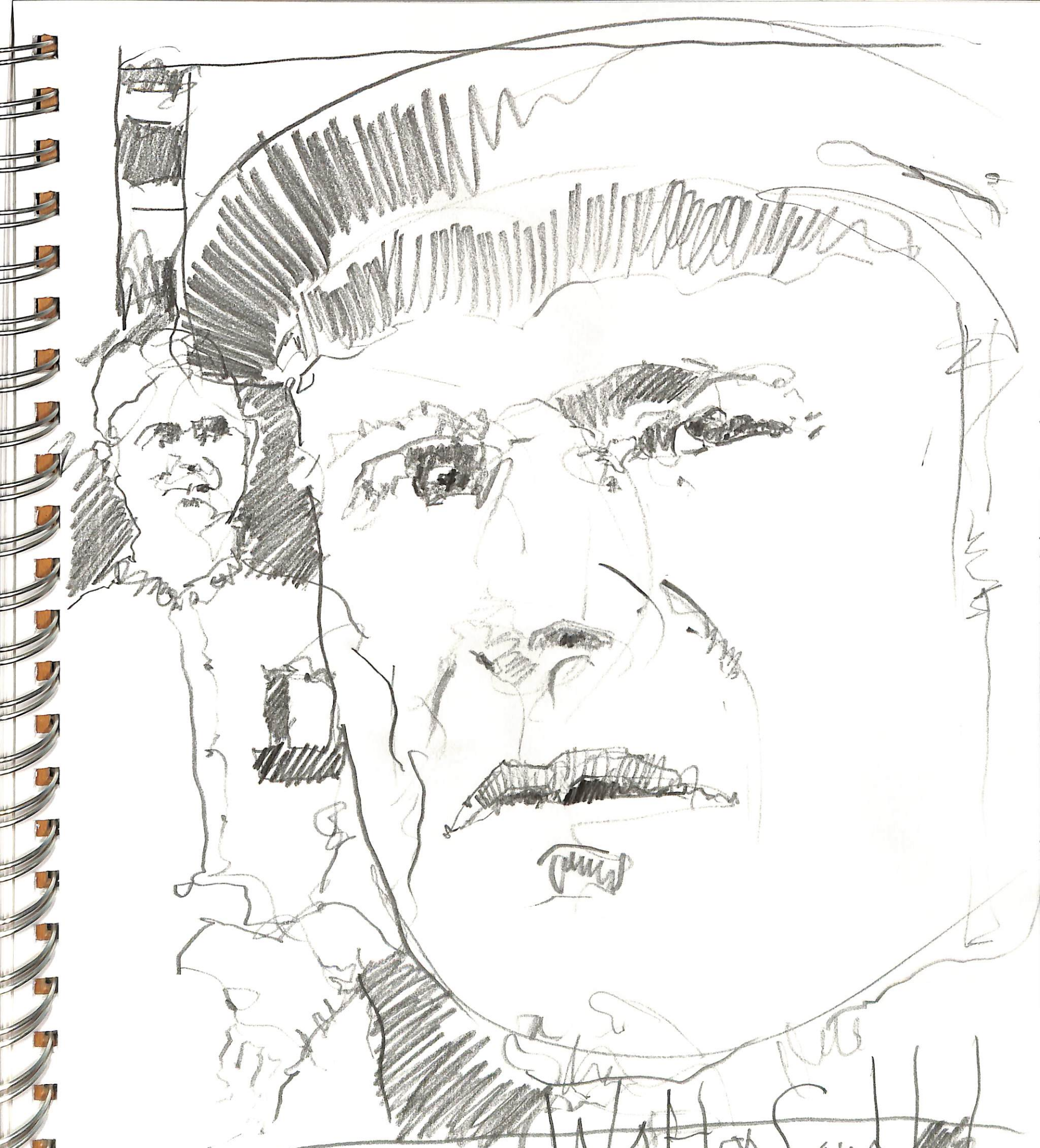

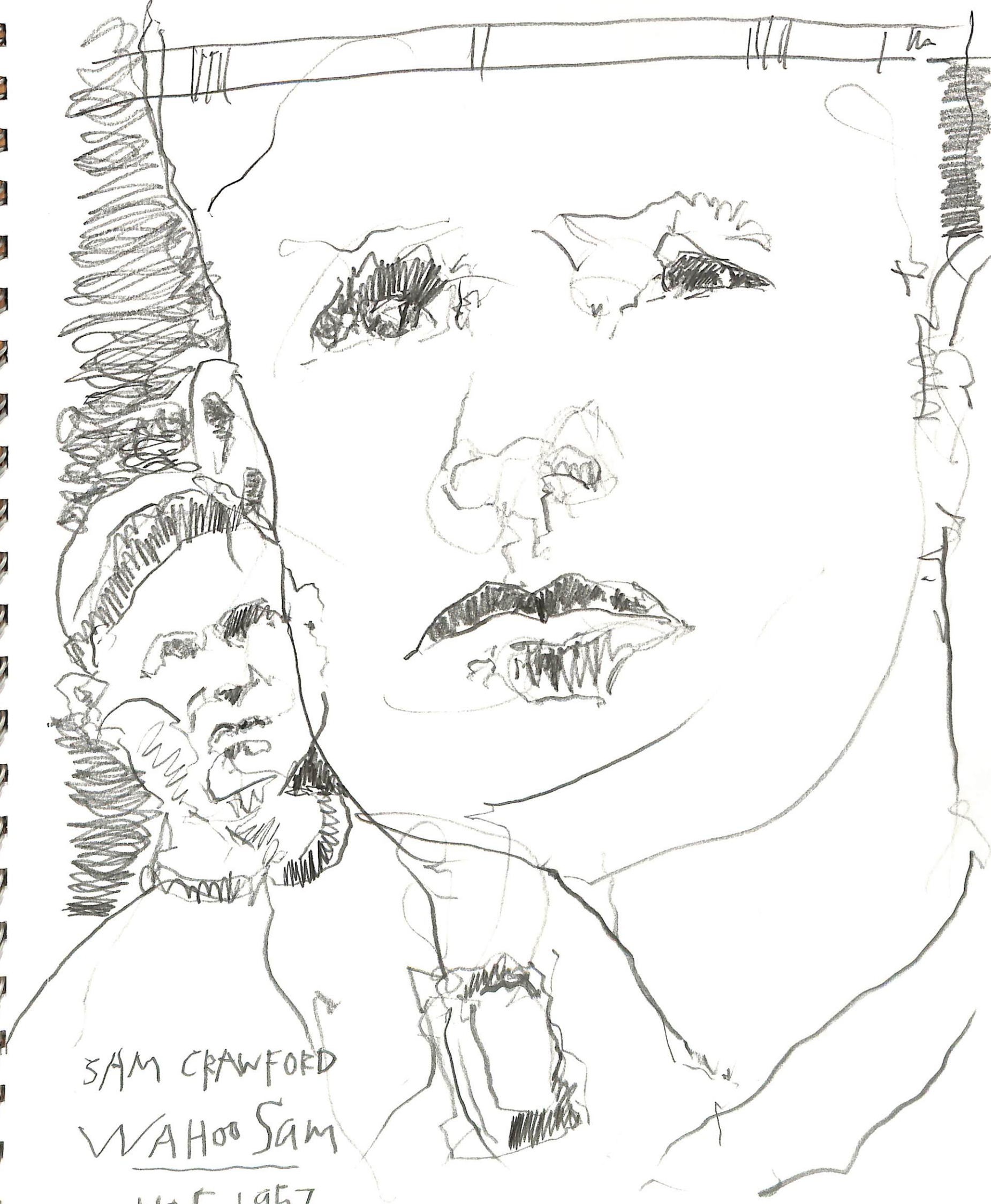

- LEFT FIELDER
- 5TH HIGHEST BATTING AVERAGE IN MLB.

HOF 1945

- DIED FALLING INTO THE NIAGARA RIVER
AND EVENTUALLY WENT OVER THE
NIAGARA FALLS AFTER BEING
REMOVED FROM A TRAIN BECAUSE HE
WAS INTOXICATED. HE WAS 35 YRS. OLD.

BORN IN CLEVELAND OHIO

- Spent most of his time with the Philadelphia Phillies.
- VERY powerful hitter.
- HIGH BATTING AVERAGE .407
- 1896 HIT 4 HOME RUNS IN ONE GAME! (2 WERE INSIDE THE PARK.)
- only man to date to win a batting title in the AL & NL.
- Phillipsburg, New Jersey, "Delahanty's Tavern On the SQUARE"
Named in his memory (NOW CLOSED)

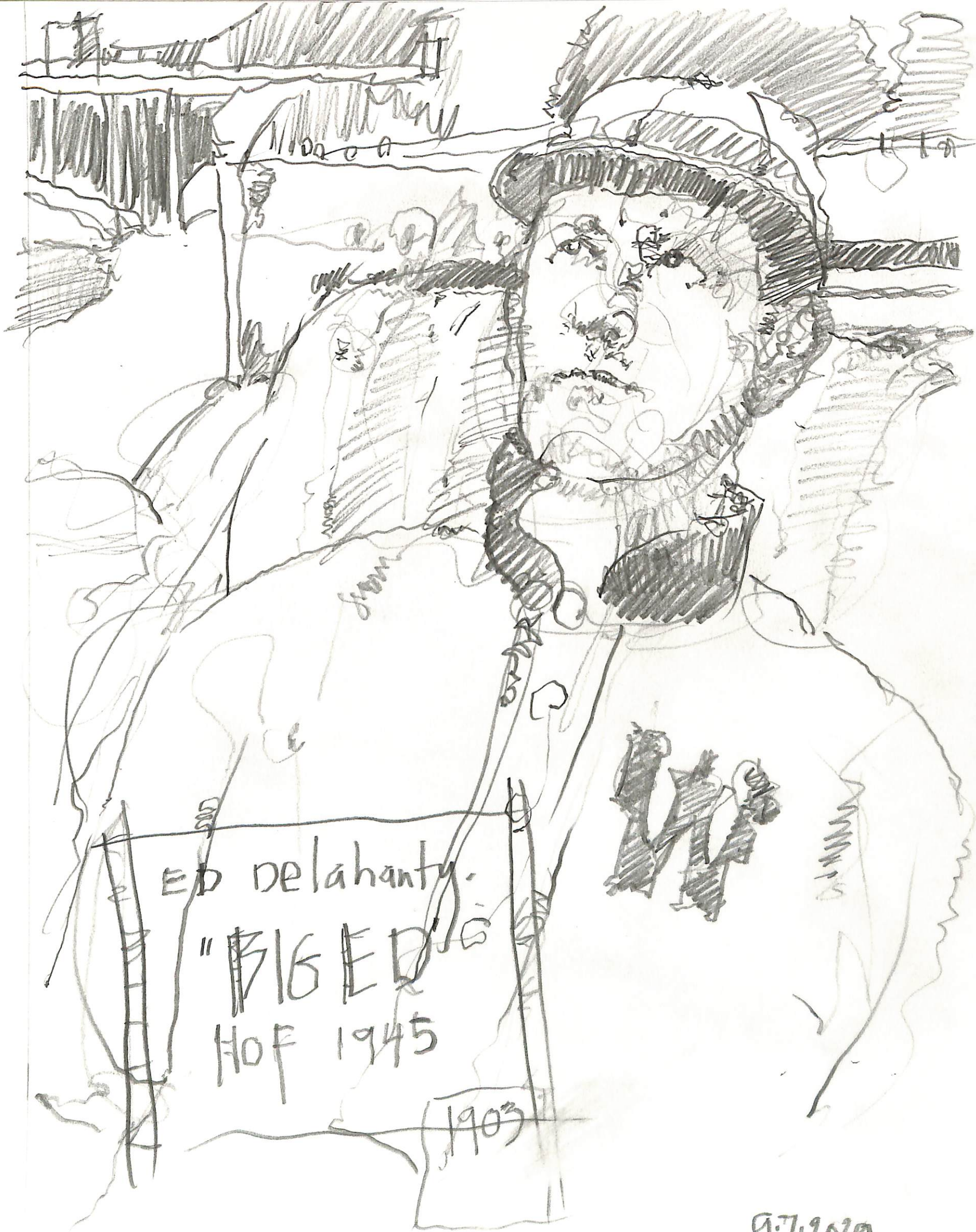

PRINT TECHNIQUE

9.20.2020 ELMER FLICK.

- use team photo as trim/repeated pattern

• top of Head OVER repeat

• Bottom of Body - Blend in with pattern/design

• Possible light color field behind.

• Order of drawing

1. Head/Body.

2. upper trim/behind

3. lower trim/work in to body drawing.

• Color of illustration dictated by uniform colors of the time

• name on painting to mimic the way he signed autographs -

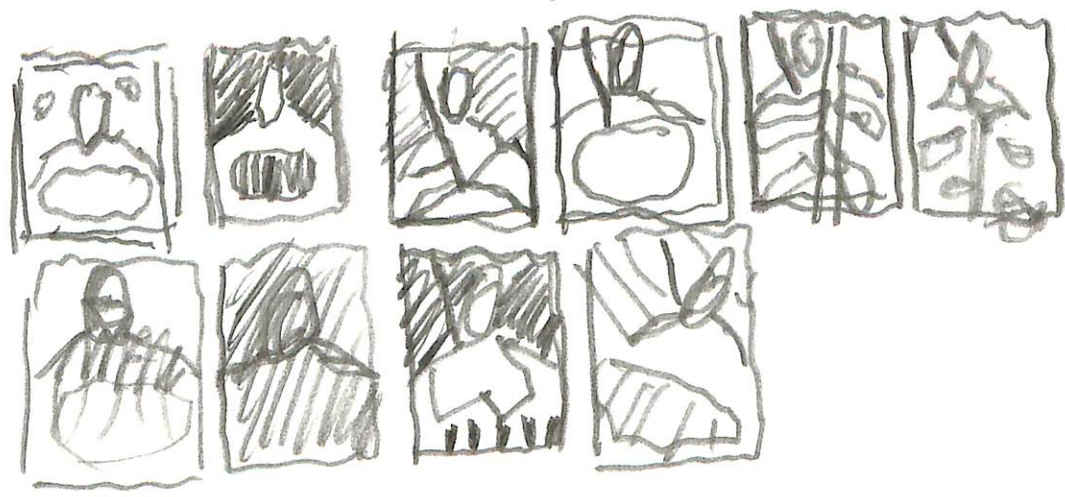
